#### **PWD DISBURSEMENT,2025**

On 24<sup>th</sup> December,2025, the Disability Fund Management Committee of the Bosomtwe District Assembly organized a short but epoch-making ceremony to present business capital to deserving beneficiaries of the Disability Common Fund. In all twenty-nine (29) deserving PWDs who had earlier been selected and assessed were presented with various amounts of money to be used to expend and/or start their income generating businesses.

The DFMC at its last meeting decided to stay away from big ceremonies on disbursement days and cut down on the amount of money spent on the day by having a short and less costly ceremony. Therefore, the exercise took place in front of the office of the Department of Social Welfare and Community Development.

In attendance was the District Chief Executive, the GFD representative of the district, the District Social Welfare Officer, Staff of the Department of Social welfare and Community Development as well as beneficiaries.

The district social welfare officer welcomed all present to the occasion. He went on to thank them for honoring the invitation and promised that it was going to be a short and direct ceremony.

The NCPD representative in the district advised all beneficiaries to make good use of the Capital being given them and make sure that they feed from it. He advised that there is dignity in labour and implored them to desist from begging and work tirelessly to earn a living since disability is not inability.

The Chief executive encouraged all beneficiaries to work hard to feed themselves and their families.
